n. 1. Enemy

[Granny May, The Butcher, Chuck the Evil Sandwich-Making Guy and Dr. Two-Brains are some of Word Girl's foes.]



melody

n. 1. A song or a tune

[We listened to the mommy bird chirping a sweet *melody* to her four new babies.]





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adj. 1. Doing something in a way that is reasonable and acceptable.

[It was difficult to eat our bumblebee cupcakes in *moderation* because they were just so tasty.]





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something happens late than it should

[The baseball game start time was *delayed* due to the heavy rains.]





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calorie

n. 1. a unit of heat used to indicate the amount of energy that foods will produce in the human body

[Though our July 4th Flag Cake has fresh strawberries and blueberries on it, it is still a very high-calorie treat.]



exaggerate

v. 1. To think of or describe something as bigger or greater than it actually is

[Did Owen's dad exaggerate when he said that he caught the baseball with his bare hands and that it didn't hurt a bit?].





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mischievous

adj. 1. Causing annoyance or minor harm or damage

[Brady is a *mischievous* little pooch; he always steals our things then runs away and hides them.]





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
